4. **Toiletries** – solid deodorant, toothbrushes, toothpaste, disposable razors, shaving cream, shampoo, soap, and combs
5. **Paper/Plastic Products** –paper towels, toilet tissue, napkins, plates, bowls, and cups
6. **Healthcare Items for Adults** – cough drops, hydrocortisone cream, stomach medication, flu/cough/sinus/allergy medication, pain reliever/fever reducer, one-time-use thermometers, etc.
